

GRADUATESHIP SCHOLARSHIPS / BURSARIES

1. Chemical Industries (Colombo) Ltd & Institute of Chemistry Ceylon Entrance Scholarships 2009/2010

Entrance Scholarships are offered to at least two students enrolling for Level 1 in the year 2009. A special multiple choice question paper will be set to enable any registered Level 1 student to compete on merit for these scholarships. These scholarships will provide free registration and tuition for theory courses at Levels 1 & 2 and free admission for the Level 1 & 2 examinations.

About TEN MERIT AWARDS will also be made by the College to students performing reasonably well in the above mentioned question paper to cover examination fees at levels 1 and/or 2.

2. On the basis of the performance at Examinations at Levels 1, 2 & 3, the following scholarship/bursary awards will be made on merit and/or financial need to follow courses in the subsequent year at Levels 2, 3 & 4 respectively.

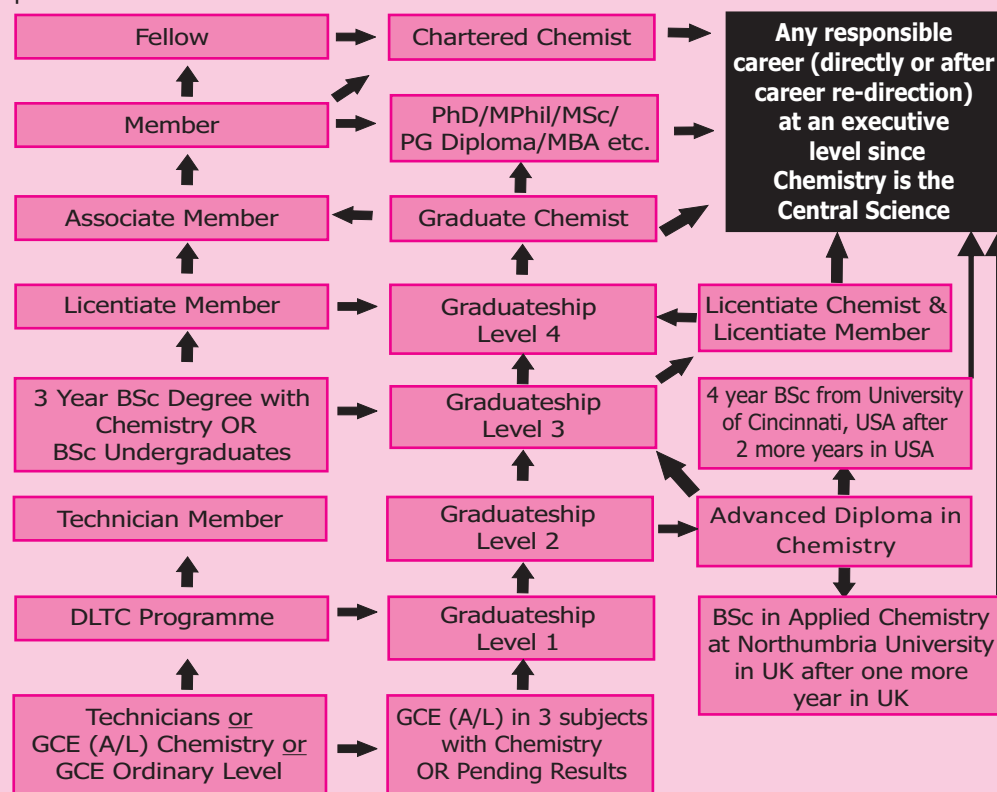
Such applicants will be invited to attend an interview with original certificates. Any **applicant who is rejected at the interview for any reason whatsoever will be refunded the payments made.**
